ORDER:

The Ministry of MSME, Government of India is Co-Sponsoring a World Bank Supported Scheme called Raising and Accelerating MSMEs Performance (RAMP). The RAMP Programme will support the Overall COVID Resilience and recovery Programme of Ministry of MSME and aims at improving market access, access to credit, strengthening institutions and Governance at Centre and State, improving Centre State linkages and Partnerships, addressing the issues of delayed payments and greening of MSMEs etc. Accordingly, in the reference 1<sup>st</sup> read above, the Ministry of MSME, Government of India has issued RAMP Guidelines and implementation Manual.

2. The Government of Andhra Pradesh has submitted letter of Understanding (LoU) to the Government of India expressing willingness of GoAP's participation in "Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance (RAMP) Programme. Further, the Director of Industries, GoAP was nominated as Nodal Officer and AP MSME Development Corporation, GoAP was nominated as State Nodal Agency for coordinating and implementing the RAMP Programme in the State of AP. Further, they were requested to initiate the process for formation of a State Programme Implementation Unit (SPIU) for preparation of State Investment Plans(SIPs) under RAMP Programme.

3. As per the RAMP guidelines, the participating states shall have to submit SIP (Strategic Investment Plan) to the Ministry of MSME with the approval of State RAMP Programme Committee (SRPC) headed by an officer not below the rank of Principle Secretary, Industries and Secretary level representation from other line departments like Infrastructure, Skills, SLBC etc.

4. In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Chief Executive Officer, AP MSME Development Corporation has requested the Government to constitute State Raising and accelerating MSMEs Performance (RAMP) Programme Committee (SRPC).

5. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Chief Executive Officer, AP MSME Development Corporation, hereby constitute the Andhra Pradesh State Raising and Accelerating MSMEs Performance (RAMP) Programme Committee (AP - SRPC) as per RAMP Programme Implementation Manual of Ministry of MSME, Government of India with the following members:

5.	Convenor, State Level Bankers Committee.	Member
6.	Chief Executive Officer, AP MSME Development Corporation.	Member- Convener

6. The above committee will discharge the following functions as prescribed in the RAMP Implementation Manual.

- a) To Co-Ordinate with Ministry of MSME on RAMP Implementation
- b) To oversee the preparation process of SIP (Strategic Investment Plan)
- c) Approval of SIP to be submitted to RAMP Programme Committee of Ministry of MSME
- d) Periodical Review of RAMP Performance in the state to ensure inter Departmental/Ministerial Co-Ordination for SIP Preparation and its Implementation.
- e) Monitoring of Fund Releases, utilisation and Audits
- f) To oversee the functioning of State PIUs
- g) Approval of Work Plan, Budget, Annual Procurement Plans and fund releases for SIP Implementation.

7. The Director of Industries and the C.E.O, AP MSME Development Corporation shall take further necessary action, accordingly.
