ORDER

In the reference 1st read above, the Ministry of MSME, Government of India informed that it is Co-Sponsoring a World Bank Supported Scheme called Raising and Accelerating MSMEs Performance (RAMP) to support the Overall COVID Resilience and recovery Programme of Ministry of MSME with an aim at improving market access, access to credit, strengthening institutions and Governance at Centre and State, improving Centre State linkages and Partnerships, addressing the issues of delayed payments and greening of MSMEs etc. Accordingly, in the reference 1st read above, the Ministry of MSME, Government of India has issued RAMP Guidelines and implementation Manual.

2. In the reference 2nd read above, the Government has constituted the AP State Raising and Accelerating MSMEs Performance (RAMP) Programme Committee (AP-SRPC) as per the RAMP Programme Implementation Manual of Ministry of MSME, GoI with the Spl. CS to Government as Chairman and the CEO, AP MSME Development Corporation as Member- Convenor and other Members.

3. In the reference 3rd read above, the CEO, AP MSME Development Corporation has stated that the Joint Secretary, Ministry of MSME, GoI, New Delhi, in his D.O. Letter dt:11.12.2023 informed that Government of India has approved an amount of Rs.107.07 Crores to our State for implementation of RAMP Programme. It is mandatory to bear 10% of the project cost on behalf of the State Government share (Rs.10.7 crores). The Government of India has also indicated that an amount of Rs.42.83 Crores will be released as 1st installment to the State of AP. 75% of this amount to be utilized to achieve at least 50% of the targets in the project by 31-3-2024. Otherwise unspent balance will be taken back by Government of India by 12.00 AM (mid night) of 31-3-2024.

4. The CEO, AP MSME Development Corporation has therefore requested the Government to accord administrative sanction and release the 10% share of State contribution for an amount of Rs.10.7 crores for implementation of Scheme.
5. In the reference 4th read above, Government have issued CBRO with allocation of Rs.11,44,60,76,000/- to the Industries, Commerce and Export Promotion Department for the financial year 2023-24, out of that Rs.25.00 crores have been allocated under HoA:2851-00-800-11-09-310/312 Development of Clusters in Tiny Sector for the financial year 2023-24.
6. Government after careful examination of the matter and in pursuance of the CBRO issued vide G.O., 4th read above, hereby accord administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.10.7 crores (Rupees Ten crores and Seventy lakhs only) towards 10% State share for implementation of RAMP Programme in the State.
7. The amount sanctioned above shall be debited to the Head of Account 2851-00-800-11-09-310/312 (Development of Clusters in Tiny Sector) Other Grant-in-Aid from the budget provision for the Financial Year 2023-2024.
8. The Commissioner of Industries shall take further necessary action in the matter to draw the total amount of Rs.10.7 Crores and disburse the same to the CEO, AP MSME Development Corporation.
9. The amount sanctioned above shall be utilized as per the scheme guidelines and for the purpose for which it is sanctioned. Implementing Agency & Director of Industries shall ensure necessary formalities as per the Scheme guidelines while releasing the grant.
10. The CEO, MSME Development Corporation /Commissioner of Industries shall take necessary action in the matter accordingly.
11. This order is issued with the concurrence of Finance (FMU-I&I, Energy and I&C) Department vide their U.O.No. FIN01-FMU0PC(IC)/2/2024-FMU-IC-IIIE (Computer No.2317096), Dt:08/01/2024.
